

Abstract

Anna Bhau Sathe, a prolific writer, inspired with the charismatic leadership of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar, committed himself to represent *Dalit* life closely, effectively and finding emancipation from the stigma of untouchability in comprehensive way. Coming from a poor background and experiencing the realities of life, he wrote on day-to-day realities, class/caste struggle and social interactions. His 35 novels, 10 folk dramas, 24 short stories, 10 *Powadas* (ballads), one play and a travelogue have been published in Marathi by the Maharashtra government in 1998 and many more remain unpublished.
